Installation Instructions:


Removal

- 1. Remove rear wheel (see service manual instructions)
- 2. Remove upper and lower belt guards
- 3. Remove rear shock lower mount fasteners and discard
- 4. Remove swing arm mounting fasteners and discard
- 5. Remove swing arm

Install

- 1. Install new spherical bearings (10) into swing arm using suitable tool (example: JIMs tool #2250)
- 2. Carefully install swing arm onto bike.
- 3. Install new mounting fastener (8), washer (11) and nut (9) for both sides
- 4. Torque to 55-65 lbs. ft
- 5. Install new rear shock mounting fastener(5), washers (2,3) and nut (4)
- 6. Torque to 29-35 lbs. ft
- 7. Install lower belt guard and fasteners. Torque to 100-110 lbs. inch
- 8. Install upper belt guard and fasteners. Torque to 100-110 lbs. inch
- 9. Install rear wheel (see service manual instructions)
