Kit Description:

This Chrome Front Caliper Kit comes complete with the items listed in the Bill of Material.

Installation Instructions:


Removal

- 1. Remove front fender (see service manual for instructions)
- 2. Remove banjo bolt(5) and allow brake fluid to drain in suitable container
- 3. Discard two crush washers(6)and banjo bolt(5)
- 4. Remove two mounting fasteners(3) and discard
- 5. Remove caliper from rotor
- 6. Repeat for the opposite caliper

Installation

- 1. Install new polished caliper (2) and two new mounting fasteners (3)
- 2. Torque mounting fasteners to 36-44 lbs. ft
- 3. Install new banjo bolt (5) with two new crush washers (6) to brake line
- 4. Torque banjo bolt to 13-17 lbs. ft
- 5. Repeat for opposite caliper
- 6. Bleed calipers (per service manual instructions)
- 7. Install front fender (see service manual instructions)
