Kit Description:

The Grip Cover Installation Kit contains all components and instructions to install a set of Grip Covers to the vehicle. A specific Grip Cover Set selection is required.

Installation Instructions:**Installation**

1. Layout grip cover (2) on grips to determine where the lacing will line up on grip.

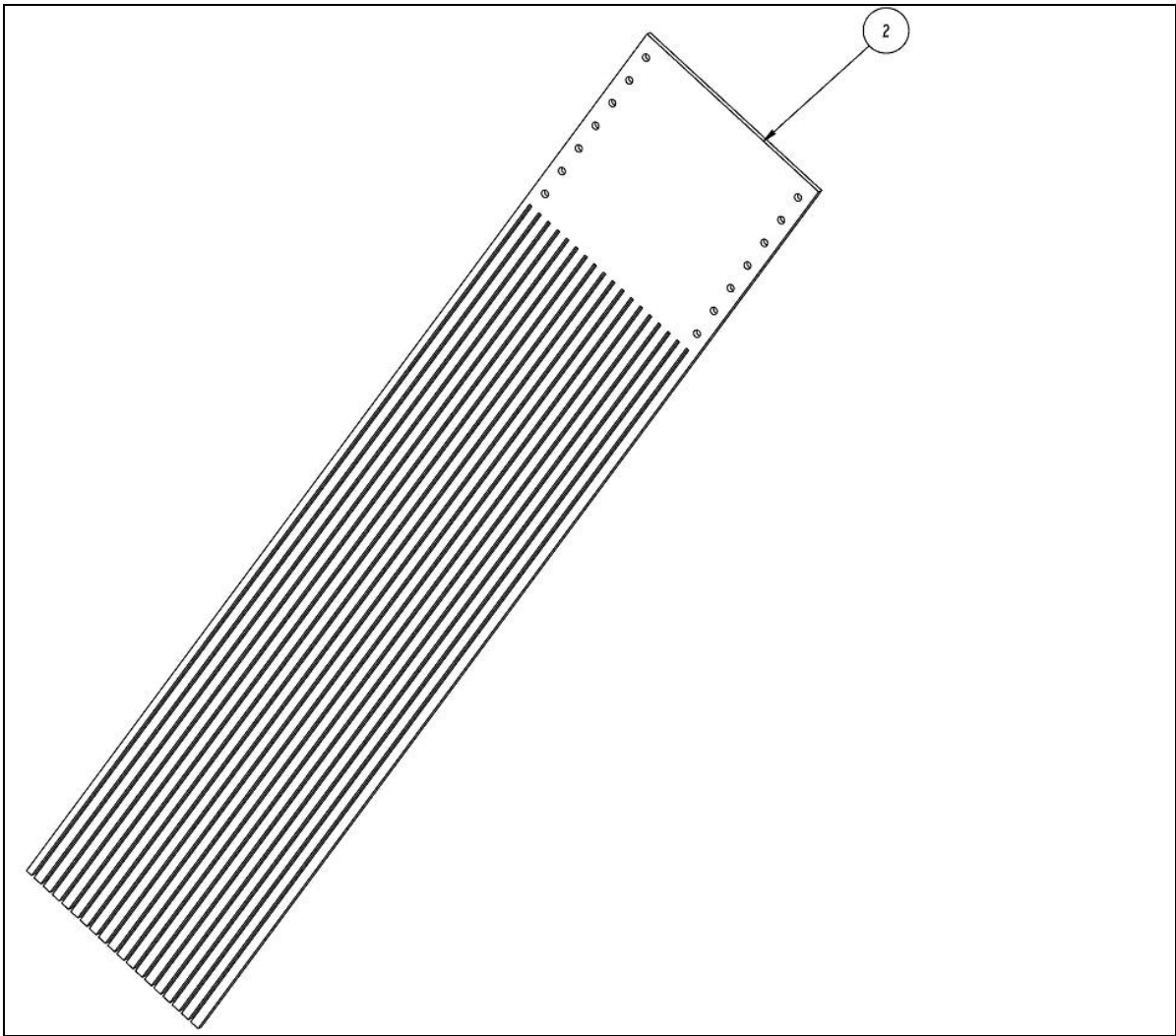
Recommendation: Have the lacing of the grip cover be about where your first set of knuckles will rest on the grip when you are riding. This is most comfortable for rider

2. The lacing has a leather side and a suede side. Always lace the cover so that the leather side is facing out and on the outside of the cover.
3. The lacing process should start at the inside (toward switch cubes) and work its way out toward the end of the handlebars.
4. Start lacing the cover leaving approximately 1.5" to 2.0" of lace at the end. This is called the tail end for reference.
5. Tuck the tail end under the cover as you are lacing the cover onto the grip. This will tighten down and keep the lace from pulling out.
6. While lacing the cover, keep pulling the cover tighter to remove gaps and slack in cover.
7. Be sure to keep the cover aligned while lacing.
8. While lacing the last two holes, do not pull tight.

Note: Keep pulling and removing gaps and slack in cover while aligning the lacing.

9. Slip the remaining lacing through the last two lacings. The lacing should end up in line with the rest of the lacing on the grip cover.
10. Cut any excess lace that hangs past the grip cover lace.
11. Repeat for other side
